**THUMB** - (Closest): Family, Friends, Brethren, Neighbors

**INDEX** - (Pointer) Pray for those who have or are presently pointing us to God. (Teacher, Preacher, Church Leader, Neighbor, Classmate)

**LONGEST** - (Highest) Those who are in high places of authority (church, government, schools, etc.)

**RING** - (Weakest) Those who are weak:

a) physically (shut-ins) b) spiritually (lost, back-sliders, etc.)

**LITTLE** - (Smallest) Also - last. Think of oneself last
