Various interpretations of this (avoid blood) Scripture have been given. One is; Abstain from shedding blood (murder). A better one is; Avoid eating and drinking blood. Such use of blood was common among the Gentiles. They drank it often in their sacrificial feasts and in making covenants. Thus this rules out blood pudding. Rare steaks have most of the blood removed prior to eating. Animals strangled and which have not been properly bled when butchered should not be used for food likewise.
