We all have two choices in life: 1) Reject this message and never look at it again. 2) Pass this along to your Christian and non-Christian friends, giving them encouragement we all need every day. When we have chosen option #2, we have chosen to STAND UP for Jesus.

In light of the many jokes we send to one another for a laugh, this is a little different: This is not intended to be a joke, it's not funny, it's intended to get one thinking.

1) Isn't it funny how simple it is for people to trash God and then wonder why the world is going to hell. 2) Isn't it funny how we believe what the newspapers say, but question what the Bible says. 3) Isn't it funny how everyone wants to go to heaven provided they do not have to believe, think, say, or do anything the Bible says. 4) Isn't it funny how someone can say "I believe in God" but still follow Satan (who, by the way, also "believes" in God). 5) Isn't it funny how one can send many jokes through e-mail and they spread like wildfire, but when one begins sending messages regarding the Lord, people think twice about sharing the message. 6) Isn't it funny how the lewd, crude, vulgar and obscene pass freely through cyberspace, but the public discussion of Jesus is silenced in the school and workplace. 7) Isn't it funny how someone can be so "fired up for Christ" on Sunday, but be an invisible Christian the rest of the week. 8) Isn't it funny how I can be more worried about what other people think of me than what God thinks of me. 9) Isn't it funny how one will stay home from scheduled church services due to company and not ask them to accompany us to church. 10) Isn't it funny how we will spend ten times as much time watching TV than what we do in reading the Bible.
