Sprinkling and Pouring of water fulfill only the first requirement. Nowhere does the Bible show the sprinkling or pouring of water upon a person for baptism. This was man’s idea. There is no teaching in all the Bible that water mixed with anything else, was ever poured or as a religious ceremony. The Greek “Baptizo”, with its derivations, is the only word used in the New Testament to indicate this sacred ordinance. It is used 127 times, but is NEVER translated sprinkle or pour. Christ was baptized but once, hence there is only ONE WAY (John 14:6):

- c) Which symbolizes the regeneration process.
