The Red Letter Edition Bible was a product of Louis Klopsch. He printed the Red Letter Edition in 1901. He based it from Luke 22:20, "This cup is the New Testament in my blood, which is shed for you". He reasoned that all blood is red, thus Christ's words should be in red, as a constant reminder to the reader.
